- Demonstrate ability to consult with other professional providers to provide appropriate treatment for the patient
- Perform intake assessments, psychosocial assessments, diagnosis, treatment, and crisis intervention of patients with psychiatric disorders
- Chart patient's treatment and progress in accordance with state regulations and department procedures, and facilitate ancillary services/community referrals
- Interpret psychiatric treatment to appropriate supports and help to reduce fear and other attitudes obstructing acceptance of psychiatric care and continuation of treatment and will maintain regular contact with families, outside clinicians, referring parties, and report safety concerns to mandated reporting agencies
- Participate in in-service training and individual/group supervision meeting and any other duties as assigned by management
